Kinross Ambulance and Fire Services Building We have recently begun the programming phase for a new centrally located ambulance and fire services building to be located in Kincheloe, in Michigan's Upper Peninsula, serving the community of Kinross Charter Township. Construction is slated for completion in 2010.

#### East Jordan Fire Station and EMS Facility


Currently in design and awaiting funding, this new facility will be located on a 10 acre site and will provide apparatus bays, offices, training areas, crew quarters, and other support areas. Early plans are for a single-story structure, approximately



20,000 SF, with a preliminary budget of \$2.4 million.

#### **Roscommon Township Fire Station**

Currently in design and awaiting funding, this 10,800 sq.ft. Fire Station and Training Facility for 27 personnel includes 4 drive-thru apparatus bays, meeting rooms, offices, Kitchen/Day Room, restrooms and shower facilities, maintenance, storage, laundry rooms, SCBA and mechanical rooms, all within a budget set at less than \$1.5M.
